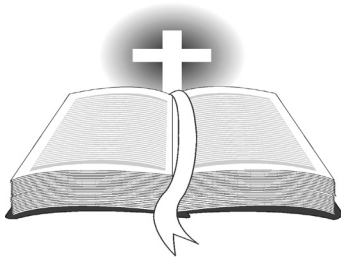
Moderator of the First Bethlehem Association.

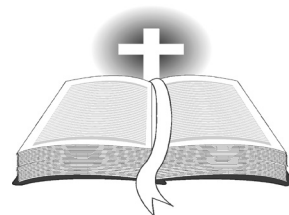
