

### 2013 PROGRESSIVE M&E BAPTIST YOUTH CAMP

nder the presence and leadership of Sister Barbara Wright, President of the State Senior Women's Auxiliary, New Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church of Tampa, FL; Sister Aquila Morgan, 1st Vice President of the State Senior Women's Auxiliary, St. Mary Missionary Baptist Church of Parrish, FL; Sister Annette Dozier, serving as Camp Directress, St. Mary Missionary Baptist Church of Parrish, FL; and Rev. Kenneth J. Emanuel, Sr., serving as Camp Pastor, Second Missionary Baptist Church of Jacksonville, FL; along with a host of other staff members, the Progressive M&E Baptist Youth Camp convened the week of June 30 - July 6, 2013, on the beautiful campus of the Florida Memorial University in Miami Gardens, FL. The camp was blessed with approximately 77 participants from throughout the State of Florida with many of them being first-time campers.

This year's curriculum continued the focus on current issues of the children and youth of today. Lessons for the Children reminded students that the Bible is a road map for life (Memory Scripture ~ Psalm 16:11), and if a choice they make leads to a dead end (Memory Scripture ~ 2 Peter 2:21), Jesus will be there to help them get back on the right path (Memory Scripture ~ Acts 26:18). Lessons for the youth were taken from "Tasty Scriptures" and were designed to challenge teens to let Christ change their actions and attitudes. Psalm 34:8 encouraged teens to have a relationship with Christ; 1 Peter 2:2-3 encouraged teens to grow spiritually in their relationships with Christ by thirsting for His word; and Matthew 5:13 encouraged teens to be salty and to show their saltiness by spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior. The youth also attended an afternoon Bible-based Abstinence class taught by Reverend Kenneth & Sister Sheila Emanuel.

In addition to daily biblical lessons for life application, students met at the Campus Chapel each morning for a spiritual feast of congressional songs and sermons by Camp Pastor Emanuel and other ministers in attendance: Pastor Gregory Davis, St. Mary Missionary Baptist Church of Arcadia, FL; Reverend Deldrick Leonard, First Missionary Baptist Church of Winter Haven; Reverend Lawrence Johnson, New Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church of Tampa, FL; and Minister Timothy Chaneyfield, New Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church of Haines City, FL.

For the first time in known Camp history, during one of the Chapel services, Teens were asked to share their testimonies about how God had and is working in their lives. This sharing led to one of the most powerful services ever imagined with strongholds visibly broken as prayer was led by Minister Chaneyfield, and campers and staff crying out sincerely to the Lord in consecration, admonition, and praise. Truly this was the highlight of the week. We thank Camp Pastor Emanuel for allowing the Lord to lead him in this service format ... awesome!

The afternoons and evenings were filled with entertaining events that allowed for full participation from all campers, i.e., recreational activities to include a co-ed boys and girls basketball game complete with cheerleaders, a fashion show, a talent show, and an oratorical competition under the leadership of Sister Victoria Roberts with the winners emerging as follows: For Children: 1st Place, Shanyah Sallye, St. Mary Missionary Baptist Church of Parrish, FL; and 2nd Place, Jhamari Jones, First Missionary Baptist Church of Winter Haven, FL. Missionary Baptist Church of Parrish, FL; and 3rd Place, Alexis Lee, Christ the Rock Community Church of Cooper City, FL.


