2014 PROGRESSIVE M&E BAPTIST YOUTH CAMP

nder the presence and leadership of Sis. Barbara Wright, President of the National and State Senior Women's Auxiliaries, New Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church, Tampa, FL; Sis. Aquila Morgan, 1st Vice President of the State Senior Women's Auxiliary, St. Mary Missionary Baptist Church, Parrish, FL; Sis. Annette Dozier, serving as Camp Directress, St. Mary Missionary Baptist Church, Parrish, FL; Sis. Victoria Roberts, serving as Assistant Camp Directress, New Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church, Haines City, FL; Rev. Kenneth J. Emanuel, Sr., serving as Camp Pastor, Second Missionary Baptist Church, Jacksonville, FL; and a host of other staff members; the Progressive M&E Baptist Youth Camp convened the week of June 29 – July 5, 2014, on the beautiful and lush campus of the Florida Memorial University in Miami Gardens, FL. The camp was blessed with over 100 participants from throughout the State of Florida with many of them being first-time campers.

This year's curriculum continued focusing on current issues of children and youth of today. Lessons for the children, ages 7-12, were taken from a Tasty Faith, Inc., series of lessons entitled, "Life Is a Trip," and included lessons such as "What Gunk Is In Your Trunk," which focused on spiritually releasing bad memories and experiences that keep children depressed, angry, and weighted down (Memory Scripture: Matthew 11:28-30); "Goals Down the Road," which focused on setting and reaching goals through prayer, determination, and direction from God (Memory Scripture: Jeremiah

29:11); and "Manholes," which focused on things that trip children up and prevent them from getting to where they want and need to be in life, i.e., getting behind in school, bad attitudes, bad behavior, etc. (Memory Scripture: Philippians 4:13). Lessons for youth, ages 13-18, were designed to challenge teens to focus on the fruit of the spirit vs. "the ungodly spices of life," such as drugs, sex, pornography, etc. (Scripture Reference: Galatians 5:22-23); to recognize the truth about things that will be posed to them by their peers and others as "lip-licking fun" when it's truly "phony boloney" that will lead them to destruction (Scripture Reference: John 8:32); and to be aware that their futures are at risk of being adversely impacted by their bad attitudes, bad behaviors, and bad choices of today (Scripture Reference: Jeremiah 29:11). First-time campers, age 12-18, also attended an afternoon Bible-based Abstinence class taught by Rev. Kenneth Emanuel & Sis Sheila Emanuel

In addition to biblical lessons for life application, students met at the Campus Chapel each morning for a spiritual feast of congressional songs and sermons by Camp Pastor Emanuel and other ministers in attendance: Pastor Gregory Davis, St. Mary Missionary Baptist Church, Arcadia, FL; Pastor Deldrick Leonard, Bethel Missionary Baptist Church, Lake Alfred, FL; Rev. Jacques C. Wright, Tampa, FL; Min. Timothy Chaneyfield, New Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church, Haines City, FL., and Min. Harold Anderson, Second Missionary Baptist Church, Jacksonville, FL.
