We must remain vigilant in our pursuit to keep the church, “Real, Relevant, and Righteous,” by continuing to fulfill the mandate of our

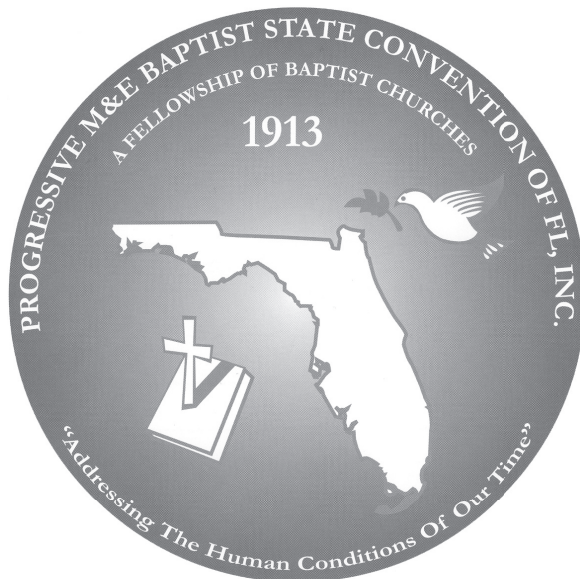
Lord and Savior to go and tell, and to be examples of Him in our walk, and a “beacon light” to the world.
